

BLOOD BORNE PATHOGEN EXPSOURE PROCESS

1. Call 803-NEDL to report the injury and receive instruction
2. Get lab labels from BBP Exposure box located in your in your dept/ area (**Labels serve as MD orders**)
3. **Draw source blood immediately** (do not let source leave till complete) Draw 5ml red top no gel and send STAT to lab
 - a. place blue label on source lab tube
 - b. place tan label into source specimen bag

- b. give guardian the Patient Results Card found in BBP Exposure box with identifier number on it

4. Draw employee blood (on unit or Test Referral Center. If after hours may use ER)
5. **Charge nurse** or designee will
 - a. **determine** if exposure to blood, CFS, joint, pericardial or pleural fluid, semen or vaginal fluid. Only consider breastmilk, urine, vomitus or stool if visibly bloody.
 - b. initiate MD consent for HIV from guardian (consent form in BBPE box or on Centerlink at Cincinnati Children's 101 and then to Employee Health
 - c. contact 736-STYK when consent obtained to initiate source HIV testing
 - d. verify source patients risk factors:

Multiple blood transfusions
History of IV drug use

History of STD's
History of newborn maternal risk factors prior to birth

History of Pneumocystis pneumonia

6. Employee Health hotline nurse gives the employee an identifier number for coding of source and Employee blood samples

7. Employee and Employee Health RN discuss the risk factors and potential prophylaxis (medicine) to reduce the risk of acquiring HIV, Hep C and Hep B.
8. If post exposure prophylaxis is ordered obtain green PEP card from BBPE box. Complete card and obtain medication from inpatient pharmacy. If you are at a satellite location PEP medication will be located in your PYXIS. Remove green PEP card attached to medication bag and place completed card in PYXIS RETURN. Kaletra can only be dispensed from the base pharmacy.
9. **It is important to remember your exposure identifier number**, how ever if it is forgotten or misplaced you can call 736-STYK to obtain it.
10. Access Bloodborne Pathogen Exposure/needlestick-Sharps Reports on CenterLink at <http://groups/healthy/NeedleStick/form.htm>. Complete and submit online. If unable to access the online form obtain the 6 pages Bloodborne Pathogen Exposure/needlestick-Sharps Report form and HIV consent from the Employee Health Website, Print, complete and fax immediately to **803-6030**.
11. Employee to contact Employee Health at ext: 6-4464 the next business day after 3 pm for a review of immunizations and required follow up.
